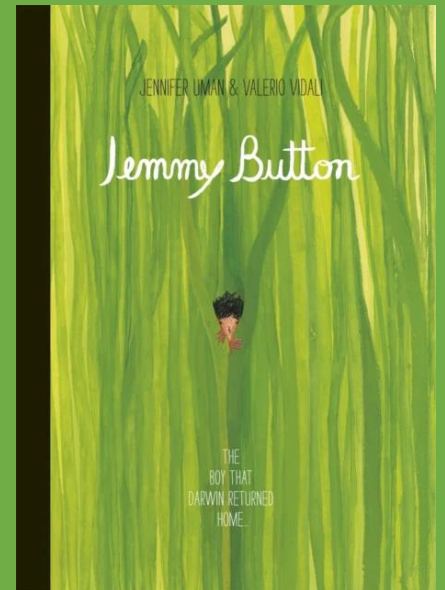


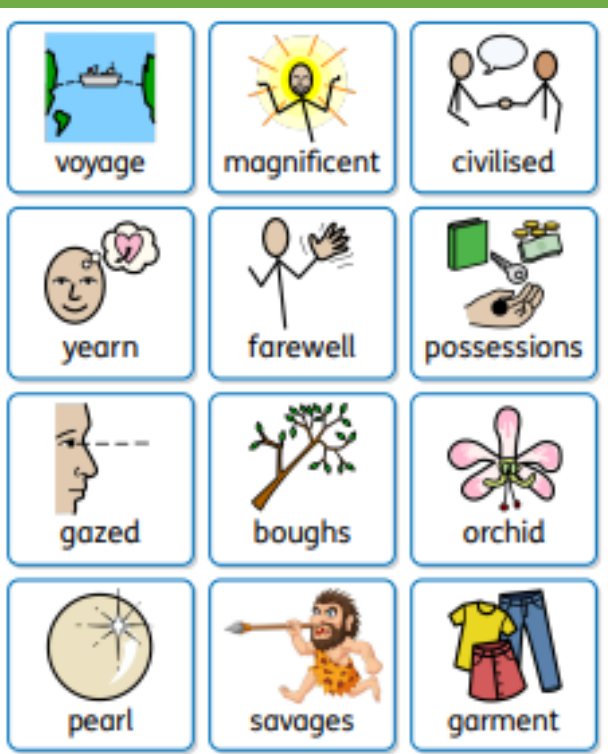
# The Firework Maker's Daughter
